

Holistic Missionary Preparation

When a missionary or church is considering how to engage unreached people groups in long-term mission work, there are a lot of time, energy, money, and relationships at stake. Studies have shown that most of the time missionaries return early from the field, it is due to inadequate preparation or unhealthiness that wasn't discovered before they left.

Before missionaries launch, or before a church sends mission workers, it's important to be sure that they are emotionally, relationally, and spiritually healthy. Mission Resource Network (MRN) has a preparation process that begins with an assessment. The assessment is meant not to deter but to help those who are called by God to develop what they need to fulfill their calling. It's not to gauge if they are capable to do missionary work, but to be sure they can embody Christ in a healthy way in their marriage, family, finances, physical well-being, etc.
